# **REQUIREMENTS**

#### Cost:

The base cost of the trip is \$385 + airfare (estimated between \$400-\$500) per person. Final costs depend on when you register. During travel, there will be (4) meals at your own expense. Raising support is encouraged to help with trip costs. A sample letter of support is available upon request.

### Travel Requirements:

Participants must be 10 years of age or older to participate, accompanied by their guardian.

A Passport / Passport I.D. Card is required for each traveler. You will not be permitted entry into Mexico without it. Please note, StoneBridge mission trips are alcohol-free during travel and throughout the duration of the trip.

## PLANS

#### Travel Plans:

We'll fly from Omaha to Phoenix. You have a choice to fly out early Friday morning or later Friday afternoon. You are going to be responsible to book and pay for your airline ticket. We will be providing the flight information (*months out*) of our trip leaders so if you would like to fly out with StoneBridge members you are welcome to. If you arrive later than **7p** in Phoenix you will be responsible for your transportation to the facility where we are staying on Friday night.

We will get up early Saturday morning and drive to Puerto Peñasco, Mexico in 15 passenger vans. The drive takes approximately 5 hours. Saturday through Monday we will build the house. Then, we will drive back to Phoenix on Tuesday, leaving Puerto Peñasco, in the morning.



## **DETAILS**

### Housing:

In Phoenix we'll stay at Central Christian Church—Mesa Campus.
In Puerto Peñasco we will stay in tents rented from Amor Ministries.
There will be 2-3 people per tent; tent arrangements will be coordinated at a later date.

#### Food:

Food during the travel from Omaha to our site in Mexico (and on the way back) will be your responsibility. This will include Friday breakfast and lunch, and Tuesday lunch and dinner for a total of (4) meals. In Puerto Peñasco, all your meals are included in the cost of the trip and will be prepared by Baja Camp Cooks. We will have hot meals provided for breakfast and dinner (beginning with dinner on Saturday night). During breakfast, Baja Camp Cooks will set up a preparation station where each person can make a sack lunch to take to the work site. Water is available 24/7. Campfire snacks will be provided each night following dinner.
